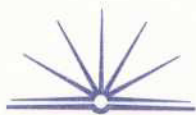
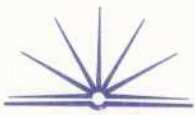


a1. the father changes from being a man over doing his work and not paying much attention to his kid to getting away from work and playing with him/her (the kid)

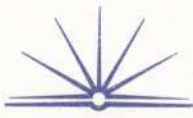
a2 one of the visual features is that the father is shrugging his shoulder (no got to work). ~~is~~ ^{to} looking out the window and going to play with the kid.
