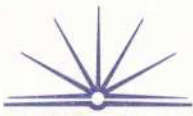


The consequences of change have ~~been~~ shaped my understanding through the techniques used in the film 'Much ado about nothing' by Kenneth Branagh, Novel-Back on track, stimulus material - Poem 'The Door' by Miroslaw Holub. & a magazine article about a family in crisis.

The consequences of changes can be very damaging sometimes when a change is negative or something bad happens. In the ~~the~~ film 'much ado about nothing' For example consequences of change happen Don John a mean man tries to destroy Hero & Claudio's relationship, by devising a plan that involves Borracchio (one of Don John's officers) & Margaret (Hero's maid). They are in a scene where they are making love, Don John is talking to Claudio & Don Pedro outside the window of Hero's room where they saw what they thought to be Hero being unfaithful to Claudio with another man. The consequences of change here have been very dramatic and a whole relationship can change in just a split second. Also in the ~~film~~ ~~this~~ novel 'Back on Track' by Margaret Clark, a young girl 15 yrs Simone moves from living with her sister & going to school to living in shelters & taking drugs where she became addicted & ended up in a series of bad situations such as getting rape & pregnant, being addicted to drugs (speed). This led to bad consequences of changes as she <sup>run</sup> ~~moved~~ away from home (safe enviro) she became involved in a different scene with bad influences. The changes have occurred shape my understanding
