This book is great to use in his me program as it to shows the reality of ibstitutions and that not all imsbehavior occurs in he city but also in the more towno such as Murgindi. When Brett anises at the form' his preconciled dears of it keing like a joil or pr conentration comps was removed. He noticed here were ho "bolts barbed wire leaving and looked like a school with a wicket pitch and nurato or he walls. He is introduced to he institutions worden's 'Many and Som who appear to be findly people, 50 interested in Brett's background and calling him by his first nome not like he police who called him "the boy. This attitude by he police almost dehumanised Brett as he **ND** longer was considered human to hern. Even hough Brett could see a stork contrant in attitudes between

he police and Som and Many, he still had a rebelliour noture and was confident that he could "buck the system". One might ask how Brett Dalton, a criminal, a rebellious and obnexious teenager managed to change. This is due to the difference approach by the instribution. This feat is also appropriate to use for he program as it shows people what he effect of indiviator on each other and how one can almost dehumanisk one onoher. Bolling charged attitude Bretts draged attitude is seen in he incident when he inmates are allowed to go into society to attend he nodes. Blett blooks Three inmates, Beg, including he pungest innate of just twelve years, Frog, were

not able to handle he free choice in society and hey got included in trouble. Brett managed to protect thog from getting involved in a drug dealing and got that physically injured to ensure Frogs safely. This incident demonstrated bretts learned care and protection for another person, not just for himself, as the he had point to The farm. Here land that the North deant rehatititate everyone He also learns about trust and love how his Lew girlfnerd laitlyn who Mark uses an Mongh characterisation to represent Brett's future ons one of to love and hoverty. This love and control is demonstrated when Brett goes on a horse ride to Boomi and has to "tame" he horp. This acts as a metaphor to phow how Brett was an uncontrol peron who needed he core and not control from he motivition keredde to anable a dramatic charge in his life. But manot all institutions be do rebubilitate heir ihmates which is why his text is good as it should hat Typon is not able to live in society and is sent

to another prison, unchanged. It also shows how one a can be come reliant on he institution as we learn about Josh who was raped as a child and loves som like a father. He has chosen to rather live inte institution and comply by he wles rater than living in society. Marefect of that the is This effect of notivition is seen in the more "Sleepes" directed by Barry anson where four young boys Marcano, Reily, Silliven and Corerzo connect petry junnele inhus but one day accidentally will a hot dog verdor owner ad find henselvers in he "Willewoons Kome For Boys". Unlike the fam in Raws, this institution has he overt oppearance of a school but the course appearance of a hand walled prison. The boys are conpolled by pe Sandistic worder Sean Nokes, who contrast to Som chooses to use the institutional policy of loss of identity and violence on he markes he boys Ship nated and one given a number. He also perfor performs "special acts and several bearings" which

leave her scared both fiterally and metaphosically for life. Once key one let free for the prison, have rear, Marcano and Reilly, like typos, are wable to conform to society as have two men have been "hannted as by our experienced and become "Kello titchen Kitmen". Ney end up killing he worden and die due to any one dug overdooses at on early age. The other two men, Marcano and Reily have also been traunted but have used he strict violent many of he institution to help here to conform to society and become suckesoful. As seen his motivition is different no ne rani and that has deffected effects but it is a good that to use as it shows a different approach to criminals and even juvenile crimes, rearlying theiter rebellion or conformity insocrety as a result of the effects of her institution and bis personal experiences. intusively photographed the Villawood the Repention Centre pare is a still photograph in he article which shows have young boys holding onto bors. This disturbed me as unlike he inmates in Raw polosioners and Sleepers who are forced to affed the inotitions, here boys are repogees ashe have not done any tring wrong to to descence to be have. They are skin and here and have resorted to perforce harsh harsh preatment and boredom by "swing her lips together" ad "hager strikes". This may the shows the loss of preedom and childhood part have bage are experiency. whits whitmost was photographing he distinction she met a family who are refigees from Iran. Their son Shayan, just seven years old had been in he ilstimition for Brus this and have suffered "physical and mental post trainatic & stress synchronie. His ams lay draped over his Fahry as he was too weak to speak. He has been unable to live in society as he is too provincetized by he effect of his institution and needs to live in a hospital. choise to republicitage These texts Dhow how difference institutions

or repros their innates has not all institutions have a positive effect, but off often are detremental and theating to an individual. They are very appropriate for his program and could inform people on he popical issue about do istitutions have a purpose and make people question the success rate of conforming and rehabilitated individuals in our society once released.
