It is the result of over-population in a certain area which causes people to move to housing with cheap rent and a small amount of living space. Urban sprawl has also resulted in a large amount of unemployment in Christchurch, with many families suffering from

low income. The Christchurch urban area has gradually been suffering from Deprivation, which is the state of being worse off than the society in which you live. This is the main reason for urban sprawl. Urban sprawl, in this case, is not a good thing. It is resulting in more people who are more deprived, moving to areas which once only suffered a small amount of deprivation. Without action, this could result in almost all suburbs of Christchurch suffering from deprivation.
