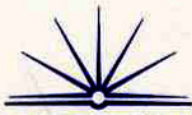

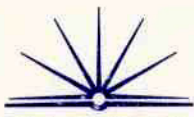
Speer was then asked to design the Nuremberg rallies where Hitler and other high ranking officials got to talk.

to minister for armaments which was a big step up from an architect.

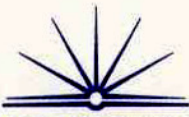
Speer had total control over what went into the war effort and what didn't.
