26 a) A coach can evaluate skill instruction in many ways. The easiest being asking the players to show him/her The instruction of a skill involves breaking the skill to certain areas. For example kidding a football involves dropping the ball in the right place, Liming the foot coming through, kicking the ball on the laces of your boot! and the Collow through. It is rare that an entirely new skill has to be learnt. when kicking a football dropping the football in the right place can be picked up quiddy as a it is a skill most people can do. The coach can evaluate the learning on how quiddy the skill progresses as well as the correctness of technique. If the skill is failing but the majority of the technque is good then the instruction is effective because it will take little work the next time to improve
