- (a) Outline TWO socioeconomic determinants that contribute to health inequities experienced by Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples. 3

wage rates - Aboriginal and Torres Strait  
islanders weekly range <sup>averaged</sup> is around \$300-400 a week  
compared to Non indigenous is averaged at the \$600 mark.  
This disadvantages ATSI as it limits them to certain health  
care services and products.

employment - ATSI less likely to be employed and therefore  
completely limits expenditure on health care, reasonable housing
