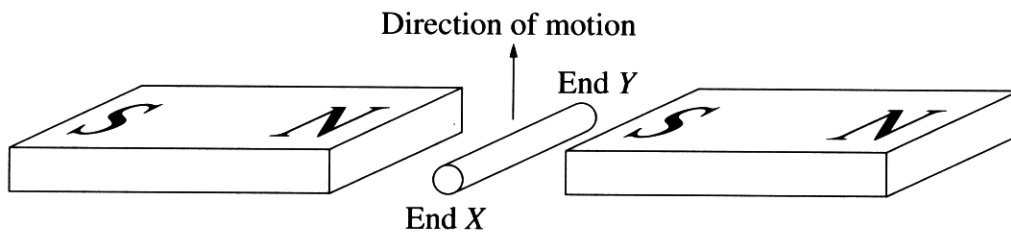


Question 23 (7 marks)

- (a) State Lenz's law. 1

an induced current is such that it's field opposes the field which produced it.

- (b) When the metal rod is moved upwards through the magnetic field as shown in the diagram, an emf is induced between the two ends.



- (i) Which end of the rod is negative? 1

The electrons due to force  $\vec{F}$ , accumulate at x.

- (ii) Explain how the emf is produced in the rod. 3

as the conductor is pushed up through the magnetic field  $\vec{B}$  at velocity  $\vec{v}$ , the electrons are subjected to force  $\vec{F}$  which is perpendicular to  $\vec{v}$ .

- (c) Explain how the principle of induction can be used to heat a conductor. 2
