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9 Australia is seen as a society free of discrimination and predudice. However groups Suchas gender, religion, disabled and older people have been or have experienced some forms of discrimination. This cancels the myth of Australia as an egaliterian society. In Australia the most discriminated group 15 He Aboriginal peoples, Australias indigenous community Over history and still today they face previdice and institutional discrimination. It is this historical background and past British actions that have labeled them and condemed them to a spesified social class due to their ethnicity. In Australia Aboriginals have has a struggle for power and authority in a country that was previously theirs.

White settlement chjustafably convistated Aboriginal land. The British columnst saw there lack of language, agricultural use of the land and having no "proper "religion inhuman and uncivilsed.

This formation of preconcieved discrimination lead to a basis of historical distreatment still struggled today. The British saw them selves as superior and powerfully educated and regared the Aboriginal people and culture not much higher on the scale than the aps After genocide, massacare Brtian decided to avilise the aboriginal people. They institutionalised Aborgines in mission and reserves eradicating outhentic heratage rituals and spiribality with forced Conveston. These preduduce views perpetuated and lead to the stolen generation in 20th century. Endently white settlers disallowed power and authority from indigenous australians banshing them the lowest rancking social class. As the government at the time did failed to recognise indiginous rites inductuals that made up australian society preconceined a negative stereotypical View these people.

This resulted in there low social class as ethnically discriminated against for different. Whatst their is still being discrimination today, Aboriginals have pejudice preconceived view mastly a ther fight this makes for neg ortive social equality difficu Aborginals are one of the lowest social brackets of society in Australia. used whilst commonality on arc of equality exists induiduals the norture find difilely in breaking down Still sterestingal views. Commonalities are Simlar to all asustralians such as, government, health and medical care difference our vide these however like belief leading to as and phin etherocontrism instilled from Sence the first kerilish conisers. the time of

Over time the government has rerogensed Aboriginal discriminations and have legally mad at anti discrimination lows. However aboriginals induiduals have gained authority and power and attempted to rectify past discriminations. attempting to change social structures and erace pejudices. The Referendum # +++++ was the first infine of government in recogning the equal rights of aboniginals In census and voting. The Mabo case in 1992 craced the myth of Australia as "terra hullious. Another government annhation was the value litle act that recognized Aboriginals as inhally occuping land. Whilst these actions eraced som prejochces He majority of Aboriginals remained in law classes and still expensed discrimmation.

this is mainly because of perpetuating Ideas through various socializing agents Sich as parents, religious and peer attitude. by altering school caricular and aduct centers inductuals can learn to accept aboriginals in our society and erace negative sterotypical publices formed in the past. On a whole Aborginal class structures remain on a low level due to economic status, education and resource oppertunities. People still seem to recognise their ethnicity as different perpetuating prejudice Ideas. Some abonginals have gained the above elements and have become prodominant powerful and authoritive members of society. How ever evidence of Paulice Hansons use to power and has instilled a future of discrimination against ethic backgranded includuals in Australia to day.
