Start here. Whilst a society is a complex organisation of people, every individual holds their own beliefs whether that be a religion such as Christianity, an ideology for example fairies or aliens or just a set of values they live by In having this knowledge, it is easy to understand why and how ideology and belief play a major role in society. In order for an idealogy to progress into a fully formed Belief System; such as "aliens" to "Scientology" it must include a set of laws, an origin and a purpose, but most importantly, followers. These followers are the inhabitants society around the world that particular belief. Therefore, ideology and belief plays a role of relating individual persons to each other. The role of belief and ideology in society is also to give reason to those unanswered questions like What happens when we die?" In order to stay relevant to society however, a belief / ideology must be able to adapt to Social change including the event that those questions may be answered to some degree by science or a different ideology An example of this is the Bible that Contains its own perspective on those

Beliefs and ideologies have the role of giving us a purpose of existing, whether it be to reach "Nirvana" as we see in Buddhism or to gain forgiveness and work our way to heaven/eternal lite/our 72 virgins as can be viewed in other faiths.
