The Under the Talikan, an extremist group affiliated with the principles of Islam, women were subjected to de highly sexually distributed discriminatory behaviour and regended inferior to men according to the Islamic writings of the Rur'an. Thus rules were incorporated to prevent equality between men and women and this confining women to a set position of social subjugation in and that position op in society Afghar society. Women faited to receive substantial quantities of 10 socially valued resources such as the limited access to employment, health care and education and were confined to the home and a life of domesticity.
