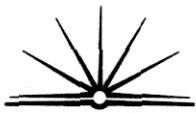




Question 21.

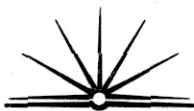

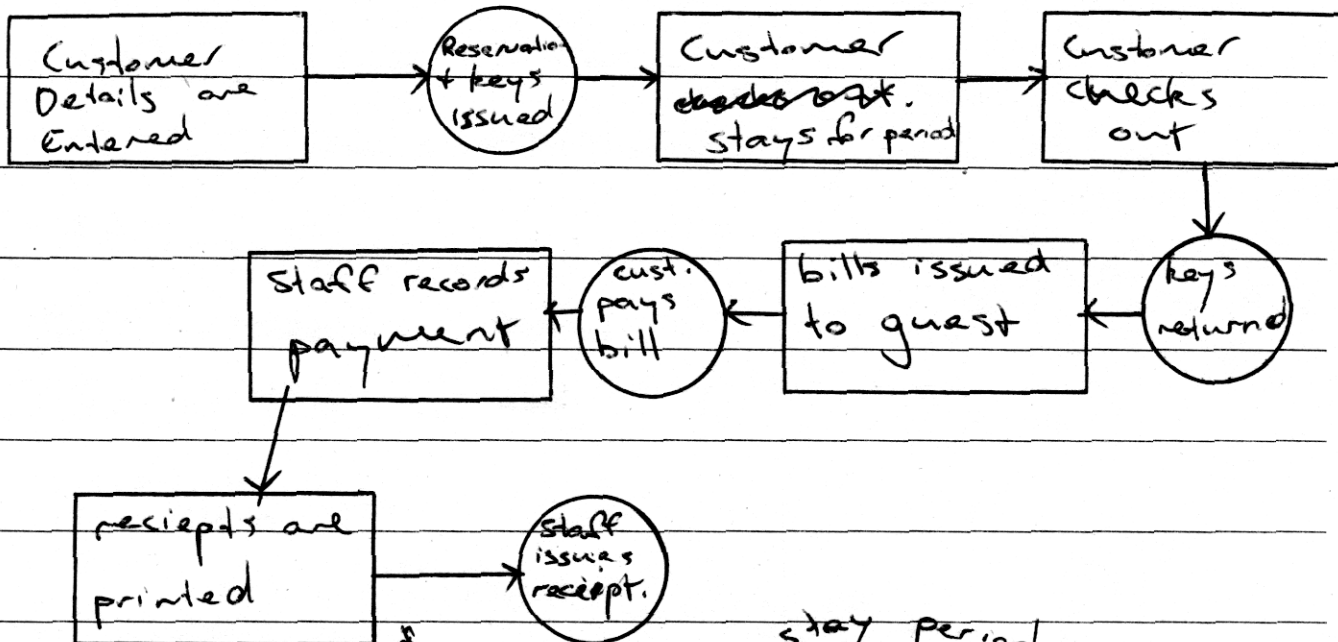
b. In this type of situation management and the project team should be extremely careful of any obstructive activity.

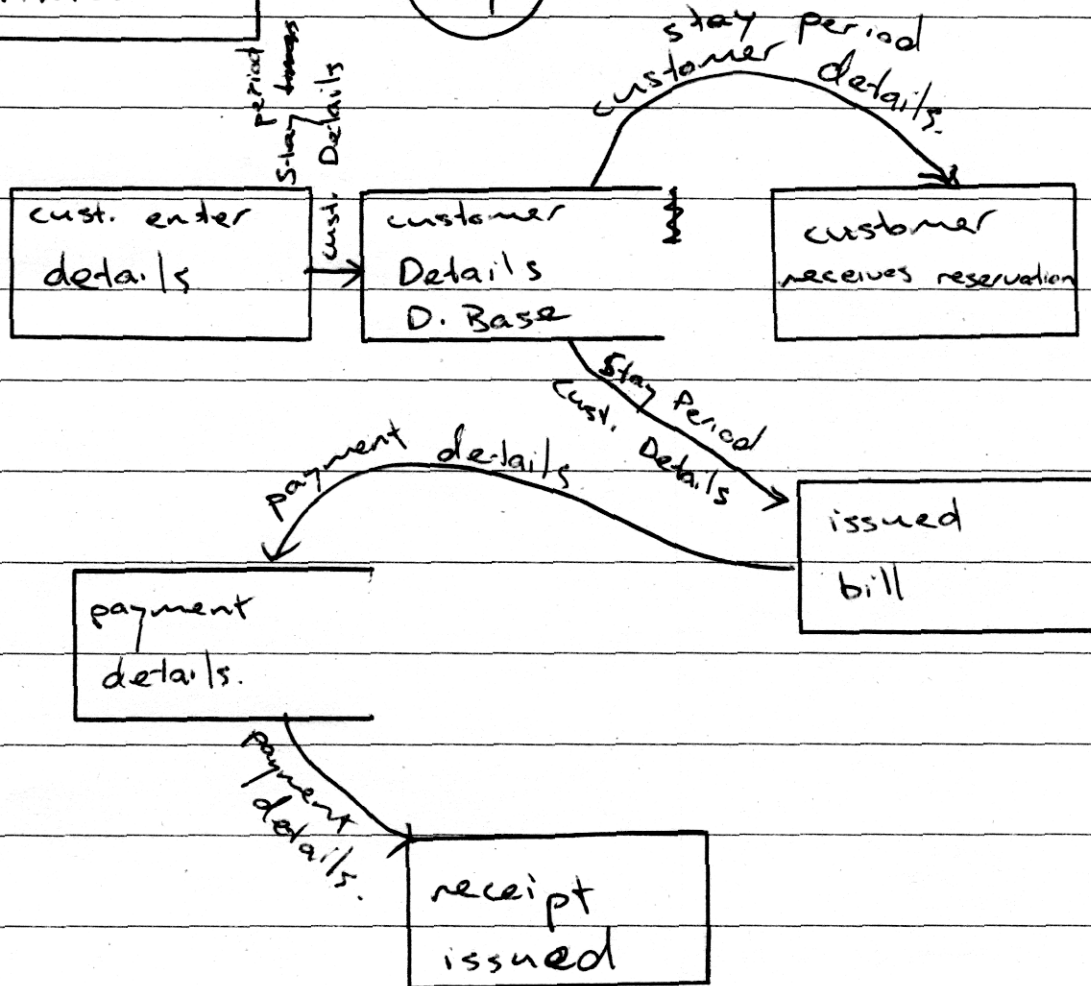

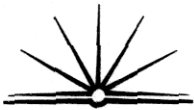
