

Martin Luther, 1483-1546 was a synifuent person in the rise of Unistionity and his belief had a profound effect on the outbone of thristranity that still exist in the modern world. huther was the leading figure in the European Reformation: He believed that Unistian teachings had strayed from their that it von 1 and that thistanty had become corrupt and were lausing people to love sight of God. In 1517, Luther posted his 15 Theses of Indulgences on the door of the Whittenberg University - This document stated 95 things that were wony with the sale of Indulyonces along. At the foundation of these belief & was the understanding that indulgences did not require a change of heart or mind, meerly money. Through giving money to the which one wis able to limit their time in purgatory but this did not acquire spiritual connection with god. Luther believed that your good nocks amounted to nothing



in the eyes of God. In 1510, huther come up with his key belief that were to lead the way for the Profestant Reformation, Something that was to profoundly affect the fature circumstances of christianity. Letter decided that faith above throws itself upon god, Justification through faith in thrist, the concept of the believes as righteous yet sinful and faith alone, grace alone, stripture alone. Letter frimly believed that many things were mong with the church including private confession and transubstantiation. In private confession, one would express their sins and woncerns to a priest or father, taking away from the connection with God - buther strongly disagreed with transubstantistum, acknowledging the wine and break to be the body and blood of christ. In Luthers opinion, this was distracting the ndividual from the true meaning of God in Luthers opinion faith alone,



grace alone and scripture alone has all that hutters views were brought forward to the Catholic Unitch and as a result was ex communicated on the 3th of January 1521. This action on behalf of the wunch encouraged others to follow in heather footsteps as he never strayed from what he believed huther had a profound effect on Unistinity, one that is still apparent today. He not only. not by intention, coused the Protestant Reformation as he wanted to protest the state of the Uhurch, but he was responsible for many thenges in Catholic practices. Martin huther died in 1546 but his beliefs continue to shape the fiture of thristanity. He had an impacting and lasting effect on the outcome of christianity with the Protestant Patomatron. Luther did not only effect the christian community but had an effect on the individual christian. heither pay resembled what God intended man to be, someone who stands up for what they believe in no matter the consequences.
