

(a) *Rabī' al-Adawīyya* has contributed to *Islam* in many ways such as perceiving what *Muhammad* received from *Allah* and interpreting the ideas to make it more simplistic.

Another contribution has been the idea of *da'wa*, poetry which interpret the *beliefs* of *Allah*.

(b) *Rabī' al-Adawīyya's* effect on *Islam* has been a great one because it has allowed many generations within *Islam* to interpret the ideas of *Allah* in their own ways to make understanding the ideas suite the life of the individual.

- (c) Juma'at or Friday prayer at the mosque expresses the beliefs of Islam in many ways. The first is the call to prayer which brings the community to gather to pray to Allah. The second is that it allows the individual to thank Allah for everything he has done for them. It allows for individual prayer as well as communal prayer. It provides emphasis on the spiritual life and how Muslims are thankful for that.
