Although both religion have been involved in forms of war, Islam and Christianity both express the need for inner and world peace and highlight the importance of peace to be spread by adherents. The New Testament is a rich source of Jesus' teaching of peace, and one of the core belief as of Christianity is expressed throughout; the need to love another "The first is this, Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your mind and with all your soul! The second in This is the Pirst and greatest commandment. The second is like it: 'Towe your neighbour as yourself. There are no commandments greater than there". "Neighbour" has been extended to include "enemier" in order to convey the importance of treating all persons equally and lovingly, as Jesus Through taught in his 'Golden Rule'. practicing Jesu' message of love herent is able to obtain adanted peace, which can ultimately to world peace

Pax christi is also an important part of falace Christianity's practice of peace. Pax Christi refers to an earthly peace of christ that is used to demonstrate the importance of sustaining world peace ar Jesu wined. The common Islamic belief in Lesser And, however, means that Muslims Jihad may only fight a war in defence. Lesser Jihad ( the struggle with surrounding evil) emphasizes that Muslims should not participate in an offencive war This can be linked to the key teachings and belief expressed in the Islamic sacred texts, that is, the Qur'an and Hadith. The Qur'an is believed to be revealed through Mihammed, who are amplifier the need to incher and wok great importance in Islam and amplifier the need for both inner and world peace. "You now come to us (O Muhammed) nothing but as a mercy and grace to the worldn" The Five Pillars are also central to the belief of inner and world peace in Islam. The Five Pillars include, Shahadah (confessions of Faith), Salat (daily prayers),

Sawn (fasting during Ramadan), Zadakah (giving alms & or chanity) and the Hajj to Mecca. These pillars are of great importance in Islam- For example , and express key belief. For example, Salat is of great importance aged it emphasizes the belief in God. The five daily prayers strengthen the relationship between the adherent and God, which results in inner peace and can a ultimately lead to world peace. This can allow an adherent to a "safe, secure" environment "with live in the prospects of a better future". Ladakan is giving alms or chanity, and requires an adherent to give compulsory amount of 2.5% of excess personal wealth. This assists poorer peoples and helps bridge the gap between the wealthy and the poor, which lead to world peac and attimately inner peace. this religious tradition is creating world peace, which can ultimately lead to inner peace. Religiour leaders of both religion

have also met in an interfaith effort to promote peace and tolerance.
