The use of description and listing of locations such as; Avabasue molles, gentle Averbia and sagiffiferosue Pathos, the arriow bearing farthinians shows the extent of his friends of loyalty in the various places they would follow him. This is contrasted to his puella, his girl in which he can only ut pauca. non bona dicta, otter a few unpleasant words she is contractingly unfaithful and unlayal as seen in, complexa thecentos, 'embraces three hundred men. the use of hyperbole to establishes his puella's unlayalty.
