

b) Trade Waste Water - Automotive workshops must dispose of any trade waste liquids in a specific manner. They must be emptied into a pit that is ~~also~~ collected on a regular basis by authorised waste collectors. This is to ensure no waste enters our waterways and no contamination can occur. It is collected to ensure the safe disposal of any liquid waste removed from an automotive workshop.

Waste (materials) - Automotive workshops must also have their materials collected on a regular basis. This is to prevent build up of waste on site and it must also be removed to be sorted from hazardous materials to safe waste which can be disposed of in a regular section of the tip.

Hazardous Materials (chemicals) - Hazardous chemicals such as coolant and motor oil must be stored in a bonded steel drum free from any naked flames. This is to ensure it does not enter our water ways and pollute the ocean. It also must be collected on a regular basis by authorised collectors to ensure its safe disposal. The chemicals can be stored in ~~drums~~ closed drums in a pit before it's collected.
